

### From the Principal...

Last week I mentioned that we had John Hattie visit our school. He has been a very important part of our journey here at Stuart Park School as we often refer to his research to ensure we are implementing change that has proven effects. Below is an example of an approach to learning that we use following John Hattie's work. I hope you recognise some of the language because you have heard it from your child.


### The Traits of a Good Learner

A few years ago our staff brainstormed what we felt were the traits of a "Good Learner". We had the benefit of having read and heard quite a bit about this beforehand, especially as a result of our work with John Hattie and Visible Learning, so we were pretty sure we knew where we were going.

We also surveyed students to find out what they thought a "Good Learner" looked like. It is interesting that 82% of students gave traits that related to listening or behaviour as the most important characteristics of a Good Learner. Check out what we came up with using research. You will find these posters in each classroom.

#### ***I can talk about what I am learning and why.***

The student understands the purpose of what they are learning and feels connected to the activity. This is promoted through teachers letting students know what the Learning Intentions of a lesson are and what the Success Criteria are.



#### ***I take risks when learning.***

The student recognises that they have strengths and weaknesses and they are willing to step outside their comfort zone as they know that this is how we learn.

It's ok to make mistakes.

#### ***I can persist.***

The student recognises that learning is hard, knows where to go for help, breaks down tasks so they are less daunting and never gives up.



#### ***I embrace feedback.***

The students readily takes on feedback in order to modify what they are learning. They embrace this as they know this is how they learn.



#### ***I am resilient.***

The student sees making mistakes as a learning tool. They persevere, bounce back from set-backs, have a positive attitude and don't give up.



We are promoting these positive attitudes towards learning to help students to open their mind and be prepared to embrace challenges. We teach the language of learning and we are finding the students are more prepared to go outside of their comfort zone; take on challenges; make mistakes and try again; and not give up. Hopefully, next time we check in on our students their answers will better reflect the direction in which we are heading.

### No Animals at School

It has been noted that there have been people bringing their animals, usually dogs, to school. This happens at the beginning and end of the school day as well as out of hours.

Please be aware that for health and safety reasons, animals are not permitted at school. There may be times when permission is given to bring a special pet to school for “show and tell”, but prior discussion must be held before this happens. Otherwise, no animals at school.



### Marathon for Kids 2019

Marathon4Kids culminated this past week with students completing their final kilometre at either the City2Surf Marathon on Sunday or at school on Monday. With over 80 students completing the Marathon this year and with each student working hard on their own personal marathon distance over the past 8 weeks, to say we are impressed with the result is an understatement.

We would like to extend a huge thank-you and congratulations to the students involved, the parents and teachers who supported them and Athletics NT and Conoco Phillips for hosting the event. This is Stuart Park's 2<sup>nd</sup> year of involvement and we are already looking forward to the Marathon4Kids in 2020.

You will be amazed at the art works and talent that will be on show at our first ever Stuart Park Arts Festival.



If you are unable to support us on the night, there will be a bucket at the front office where you can make a donation towards our fundraiser. Thank you ☺


# Book Club



Your child should have received a book club catalogue last week. Orders are due no later than **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June**. You can order and pay for your order online. It is called **LOOP**, and stands for **Linked Online Ordering & Payments**. Log-in to [www.scholastic.com.au/LOOP](http://www.scholastic.com.au/LOOP) or download the iPhone and iPad app from the App Store or get it on Google Play for Android.

For a quick start, just click on ORDER in the top menu or REGISTER first to save your details for next time


- Select your school and your child's class
- Add your child's first name and last initial (so the school knows who the book is for)
- Enter the item number from the Book Club catalogue
- You can order for multiple children at once if they attend the same school
- All orders are linked directly to the school for submission to Scholastic. Books will still be delivered to your child's classroom if you order by the close date.



You can still order the old fashion way by sending orders to school with cash or cheque. Please make sure orders are **filled out correctly** and placed in **an envelope or small bag**, so the money doesn't fall out. Please don't sticky tape money to the order as this makes it very difficult to read. Your help in these matters would be appreciated.




