

### From the Principal...

Towards the end of 2022, a policy outlining that student mobile phones are not permitted to be used in Northern Territory Government schools was introduced. At Stuart Park Primary School, we respect the right of parents who wish to provide their child with a mobile phone. However, we are required to follow the policy and will take this opportunity to detail the conditions under which student mobile phones are permitted at our school.

### -All NT Schools are phone free from Term 1, 2023

- -At SPPS, students are not permitted to have mobile phones or other electronic devices in their possession during the school day.
- Smart watches must be placed on flight mode so phone calls and messages cannot be sent or received during school day.
- -Students are encouraged not to bring a mobile phone to school. If they do, it is at the student or parent's risk. Our school does not have insurance for accidental property damage or theft.
- -Mobile phones must be switched off and taken to the Front Office before the school day begins and be collected at the end of the school day.
- -All communication between parents and students during school hours should happen via the school office.

We appreciate your support of this policy and our ongoing focus on removing disruptions to learning at school.



Our Harmony Day assembly this year will be held on Friday, March 24th.


Students are welcome to wear sunsafe orange shirts with their school shorts to school, orange dresses and accessories on this day to as part of our Harmony Day celebrations.

### More About Our School Culture...

And I, little buddy will remind my big buddy what an amazing person they are!














