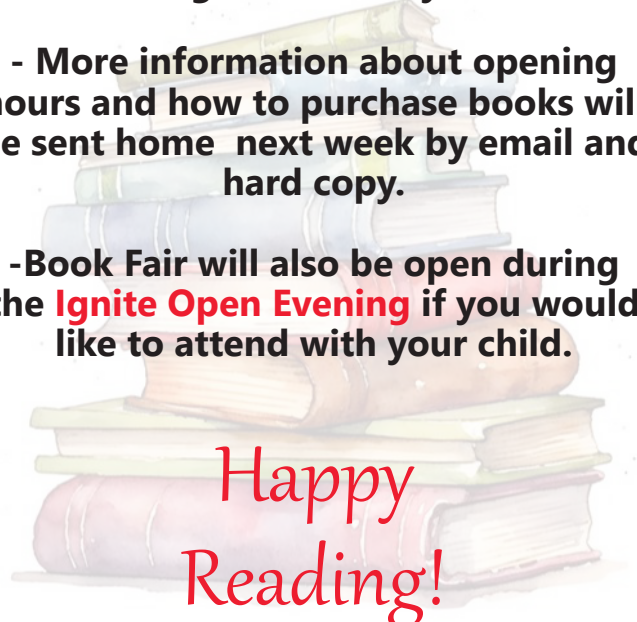


BOOK FAIR COMING SOON!

Year 3 Visit Crocodylus Park

This term, Year 3 classes have been busy learning about interesting animals in shared reading. Animals such as the binturong. Fun fact - did you know that the binturong has a buttery popcorn scent?

During our research, we identified keywords on a fact sheet, wrote them into a planning sheet and put these words into paragraphs to form an information report.

To bring the unit together, we went on excursion to Crocodylus Park, where the students got to see and learn about a wide range of animals. All classes had great fun at the park and we are looking forward sharing our information reports over the next few weeks.

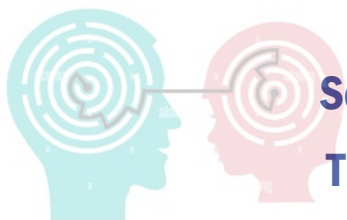
